

ḤADĪTH OF THE WEEK – WEEK THIRTY-FIVE

On the authority of Ibnu ‘Abbās, may Allāh be pleased with him, that the Messenger of Allāh, may Allāh’s blessings and peace be upon him, said from what he has related from his master, glorified and exalted is He:

“Surely Allāh has written down the ḥasanāt (good deeds) and the sayyi’āt (bad deeds) then explained: Whoever intended to perform a ḥasanah (good deed) but did not perform it, Allāh writes it down as a complete ḥasanah. If he intended to perform it then did perform it, Allāh writes it down as ten ḥasanāt up to seven hundred times and up to many times more. If he intended to perform a sayyi’ah (bad deed) but did not perform it, Allāh writes it down as a complete ḥasanah. If he intended to perform it then did perform it, Allāh writes it down as one sayyi’ah.”

It was related by al-Bukhāriyy and Muslim in their two Ṣaḥīḥs with these words.
